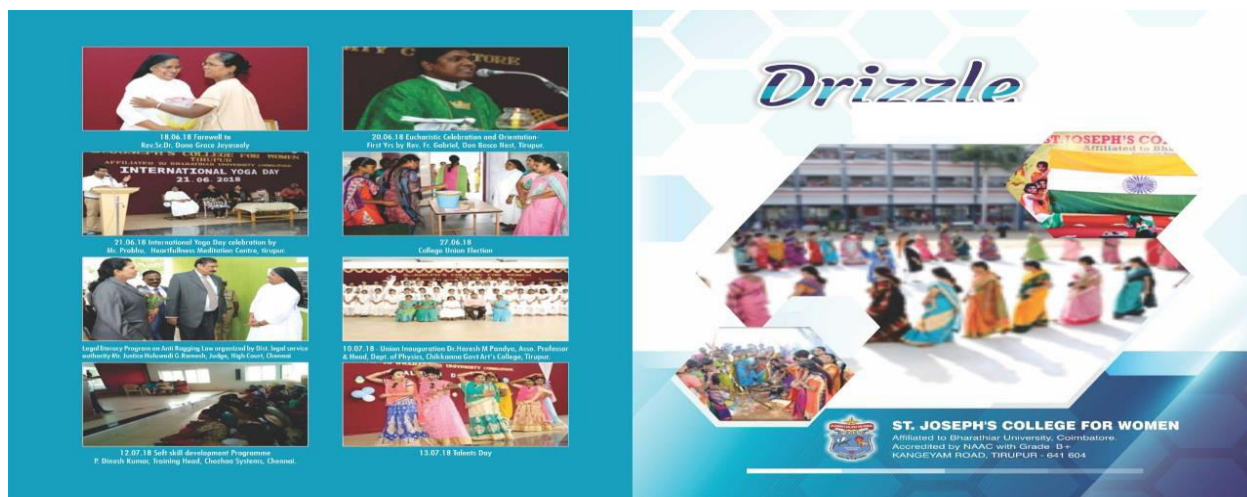

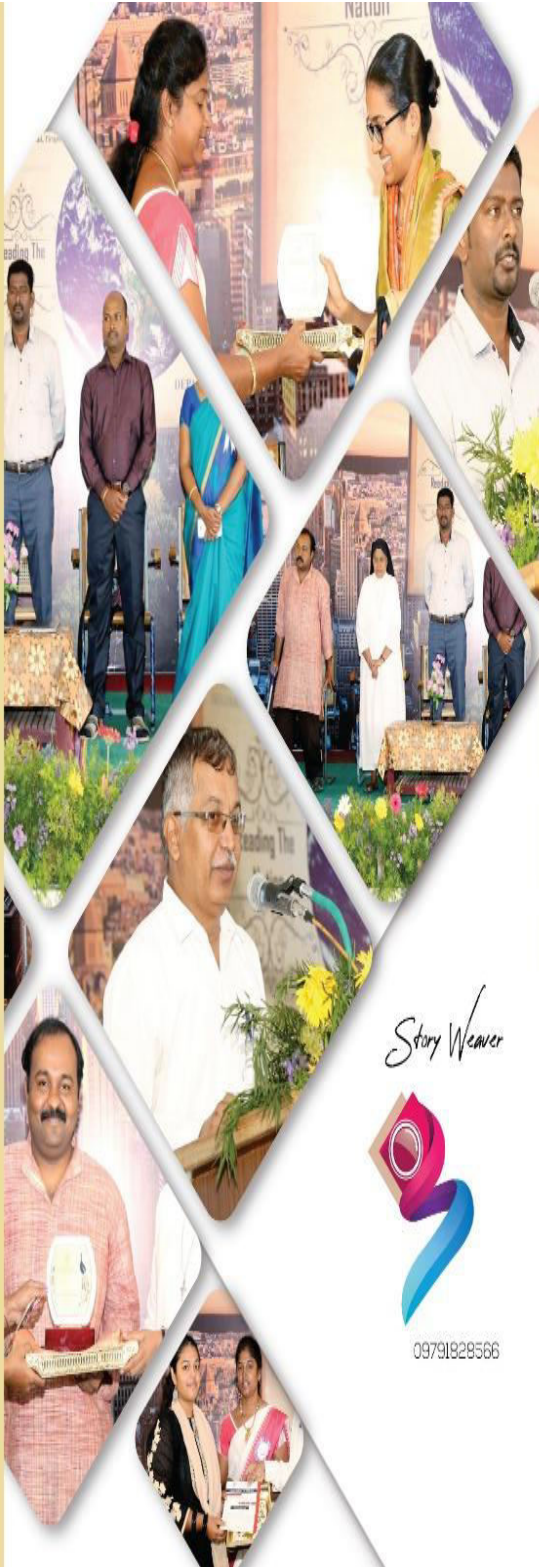

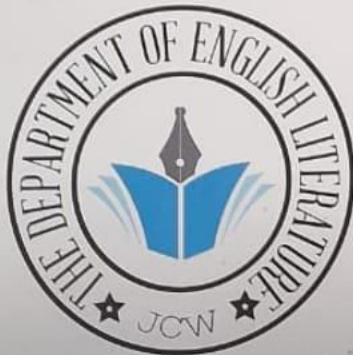

## LANGUAGE LAB

The Department of English has entrenched a modern Language Laboratory on 28.02.2020 with state-of-the-art audio-visual equipment to aid in imparting language skills. The laboratory is effectively utilized by students and faculty members for various self-enhancement and soft skill development activities. Laboratory proves beneficial for those students who are poor in use of English language. Students from rural areas who are generally weak in English can have sufficient ear training in the language lab. It aims at confidence-building among students for interactions and presentations in English. Language lab transforms a passive language class into an active speaking-based learning environment.

The basic purpose of language lab is a virtual mentor to enhance English language skills, communication skills and to practice soft skills.

Objectives of the practice:

The main objectives of the Language Laboratory are:

1. To provide a platform to practice languages and enhance students' confidence.
2. Orient learners towards self-learning and gain competencies in communication.
3. To offer career-aligned and skill-based language courses.
4. Nurture skills through continuous assessment and motivate them for better achievements.
5. Design a curriculum to cater to the slow and average learners to complete the course through systematic practice.

Currently Lady Hawk software is installed in the lab. Further this revolutionary language lab is equipped with audio recording facilities which help a great mode of evaluation and feedback. By this self-evaluation of the students' performance, they can identify the areas that need to be improved or changed.

The practice:

We have moulded the curriculum into three structures.

1. Soft skills
2. Hard skills
3. Remedial

Soft Skills:

Communication skills are the most in-demand skill that many employers look for in job profile. We give listening and speaking exercises to help the students in their career and personnel life.

Hard skills:

To perform a specific task or series of tasks to complete a job we offer Business English programme with the aim to make them familiarized with the real time language used in the work environment.

Remedial:

The ultimate aim is to help students to refresh their memory and give them their space to learn at their own pace. There are exercises to develop vocabulary, grammar, pronunciation, spelling and listening.

Courses to aid placement:

Students have the choice of opting for one or more in-build courses for the semester. In-build courses have a mock test as a follow-up activity. Students can have interactive and practical sessions based on English questions in competitive exams.

Impact of the practice:

The feedback collected from the students and faculties on their opinion about the usage of the language lab proves very useful. Particularly competitive exam preparation (English paper) and UGC NET Mock test for the faculties who are aspiring to clear the exam (1<sup>st</sup> paper).
