Beginning the day with prayer instills a spirit of confidence and fosters a sense of discipline within individuals.

Policies:

- To instill discipline among the students.
- To recognize and reward student achievements.
- To foster a sense of patriotism and unity among all students.
- To build confidence in public speaking.

Practices:

- The Assembly Committee systematically organizes the Monday morning assembly, which includes the college prayer, a prayer song, readings from the Holy Scriptures, the college anthem, and a "thought for the week/day."
- The committee also arranges an open assembly for the entire college on one or two Mondays each month. During these sessions, achievers are honored, important announcements are made, and the office bearers of the college union are introduced. These assemblies also aim to cultivate patriotic fervor among the students.
- The open assembly is subsequently addressed by the Principal, who imparts values and moral teachings intended to provoke thoughtful reflection among both staff and students.
- Achievers from various fields (academics, cultural activities, sports) are recognized and awarded during the open assembly, acknowledging their efforts and inspiring other students to strive for excellence.
- On other days, the Morning Prayer consists of the college prayer, a prayer song, inspiring thoughts, and reflections on significant national and international days.
- The committee assigns one department each week, on a rotational basis, to conduct the assembly. This practice fosters a sense of responsibility and confidence among students.





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Outcomes:

- The assembly cultivates and nurtures the minds of both staff and students, encouraging them to begin the day positively by invoking God's blessings, strengthening their faith, and reading from the Holy Scriptures, thereby promoting unity in the diversity of religions.
- The assembly fosters a sense of unity among staff and students, who come together as part of the institution, regardless of age, culture, religion, or other differences.
- It helps students understand the college's policies and values, and enables them to develop social discipline.
